ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

Scenesetters and Support of Selected DV Travel

Make the following pen and ink changes to SM 5-2, dated 13 September 2000:

- a. **Change:** all references to SPASAC to USCINCEUR Military Assistant (MA). After first use of this, substitute it with MA.
- b. **APPENDIX B, p. B-1, para 3, at the end: Insert:** A CODEL SS for representatives and senators from states involved in the State Partnership Program (ie. Texas is the state partner with the Czech Republic) should include a paragraph outlining the state's ties and current activities with its respective partner country. The paragraph should inform the congressperson of his/her state's particular involvement with USEUCOM's engagement and preparedness objectives, supported through the use of Reserve Component resources.
- c. **APPENDIX B, p. B-2, para 5, at the end: Insert:** Current DCINC guidance is to pass all Balkans-related SS information to ADM Ellis' AFSOUTH U.S. element staff to share the information we provide to DVs who visit Stuttgart and subsequently travel through the Balkans. They need to speak with the same voice as USEUCOM on Balkan issues. The process will be transparent to AOs, but they should be aware that selective SS info will be distributed through AFSOUTH's U.S. channels.
- d. **APPENDIX B, p. B-2, para 8, 2nd sentence: Change:** SJS will return copy to the AO
